Social Media Post Promotion



Classroom and Assembly Promotion

Here we have provided an example script for promoting the Peer Support Group in the classroom or at an assembly. You may wish to adapt this message to suit the group's arrangements and/or aims. The message should be short and concise so it is easy to understand, in total, a maximum of 30-45 seconds.

Example script:

Our school has arranged a Young Carers Peer Support Group which will be a space for anyone interested to chat with others in similar situations, engage in activities and build on their self-care skills.
